

Dear parents/carers,

To help support your child at home with their maths learning and further their mathematical knowledge and understanding, we have subscribed to an exciting online maths learning platform - MyMaths.

MyMaths is filled with fun games/activities, step-by-step lessons and online home learning which provides both you and your child with instant feedback on your child's understanding. This will be used alongside Google Classroom to help further and consolidate your child's knowledge and understanding.

What is MyMaths?

MyMaths is a whole-school interactive resource for years 1 to 6, which can be used both in school and at home to develop your child's confidence and fluency in maths.

MyMaths provides hundreds of lessons paired with self-marking homework tasks to assess your child's understanding of the lesson content. Lessons and homework tasks are matched to the UK curriculum.

Why are we using MyMaths?

Using MyMaths, your child's teacher will be able to set work for your child to complete whilst at home. These fun and engaging activities will develop your child's confidence and fluency in maths. Your child will complete interactive lessons which provide step-by-step examples and breaks their learning down into manageable chunks. After completing the lesson, your child can then complete their 'Online Homework' task.

Upon completing the 'Online Homework' tasks, both you and your child will be given immediate feedback as to your child's level of understanding and your child's teacher will also be able to see the results and leave feedback for your child.

- If a green star appears next to a topic, they have good skills in that area.
- If an amber star appears they still have some difficulties.
- If a red star appears they need to go back and relearn the topic. Your child could try the lesson again with support from an adult to help improve their understanding.

What happens next?

Over the next few days we will be issuing Y1 – Y6 children with their own login and password so they can access MyMaths. Logins will be sent by text, so keep your eyes peeled. If you do not receive a login by Monday then please email your class teacher (see email details below).

Once logged in, your child will have access to all of the work that has been set and starting from next week (Monday 4th May), we will be using MyMaths alongside Google Classroom to help further and consolidate your child's mathematical knowledge and understanding.

Your child's teacher will be setting work for your child to complete on MyMaths and guidance on which tasks your child needs to complete will be outlined on your child's weekly learning timetable on Google Classroom.

Guides have been put together for you to look through to help you to navigate the site. These can be found on the school website.

We are sure your child will have lots of fun completing their online maths learning. If you have, any questions then please email your class teacher using the year group email address.
