Dear Nursery and Reception parents,

Concerns regarding dismissal at the end of the day

A number of parents have approached the school to raise concern that some parents of children in Nursery and Reception are not waiting in the line and are instead 'jumping the queue' by either walking around people, or ignoring the barrier and going underneath it, in order to wait at Nursery and Reception entrances.

A further complaint has been that some parents are entering the site through the car park and not following the one-way system.

When some parents have been challenged regarding this, their response has been hostile which will not be tolerated.

I recognise that collecting your children at the end of the day takes longer because we all have to wait.

However, these are not normal times and the procedures that are in place are there to enable everyone to remain safe. The guidelines that we have to follow advocate SPACE for everyone. That means following the one-way system and waiting in the same queue, with social distancing, the same as every other parent.



We require your consideration for fellow parents and respect for the school's systems that we have to implement at this time.

We know that these systems take longer, so please don't worry if you are waiting in the queue for your child. Dismissal time allocations provide a ten-minute window for each house group.
