Dear Parents and Carers,

Regarding a positive case of COVID-19 in Y5

Woodlands were advised this morning that a child in Year 5 has received a positive test result.

We immediately contacted Public Health this morning who conducted a risk assessment with ourselves, regarding the potential risk of transmission with other children and staff in the family group.

The child who started with the symptoms has not been present in school since Friday 27th November. Therefore, Public Health deemed the risk to be so low that no person needs to isolate.

The purpose of this letter is to reassure our Year 5 families.

If Public Health had deemed there to be a risk, then we would have been advised to send home the children that had been in close contact with the child.

This is not the case and so Year 5 children (and staff) can come to school as normal.

We are sure you join us in sending best wishes to our affected family.
