

#### Staying COVID Secure - Our Commitment

- We have regard to advice and guidance issued by Public Health England and the Government.



#### **COVID-19: Outbreak management**

This document is an appendix to the school's main risk assessment; it should be undertaken in conjunction with the school guidance updated by the Department for Education on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021: Actions for schools during the coronavirus outbreak. It outlines how schools would operate if any of the approaches for easing and tightening of measures, including possible attendance restrictions, become necessary in their local area. This includes how they would ensure every child, pupil or student receives the quantity and quality of education and care to which they are normally entitled, whether onsite or remotely.
