We have had a number of complaints from the community about our year 6 children's behaviour when walking home from school.

It has been reported that they are running across the road in front of moving vehicles, playing chicken, pushing each other into the path of oncoming traffic and knocking on doors of houses then running off. As you can appreciate, this behaviour is not acceptable and they are putting themselves in danger and causing disruption to members of our community. The children are still representing our school while wearing the school uniform and displaying behaviours such as the above is bringing disrepute to our school.

The children have been spoken to today about this behaviour and if does not improve, and we continue to have complaints, we will need you to collect your child from the school premises.

Could you please speak to your children about the above concerns and remind them how to be responsible and respectful to others when walking home.
