**Please support our book fair - Every pound you spend benefits our children.**

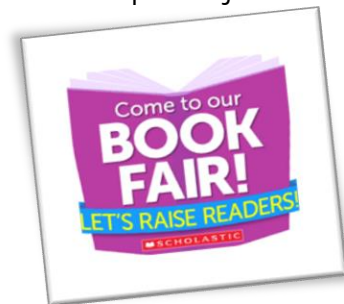


Due to your overwhelming support at our previous book fair, we earned over £900 worth of books. These books went straight into our children's learning rooms.
